II. Extension Activity Options:

1. Using the Internet, or other library materials, research the Berlin Wall. In a 1-paragraph essay describe why it was put up and how it affected the people living on either side of the wall. As a part of your essay, describe how you might have felt had the wall affected you. Use Writing Rubric Exp. I.
2. Create a map of Europe after WWII, labeling all major countries and the capital cities of each. Compare your map with a map of Europe before WWII. Write a 1-paragraph essay, comparing the two maps. Use Writing Rubric Exp. I.
3. Using the Internet or library, research the Cold War. Write a 1-paragraph essay, or create a 3-slide PowerPoint presentation based upon your research, explaining what it was, who was involved and how it affected the world. Use Writing Rubric Exp. I.
4. Using the Internet, find information about one of the world’s infamous dictators (Adolf Hitler, Benito Mussolini, Hideki Tojo) of the early 1900’s. Write a 1-paragraph essay or create a 3-slide PowerPoint presentation based upon your research describing the dictator’s personality and what happened to his nation during his rule. Use Writing Rubric Exp. I.
5. Teacher generated activity, approved by the site administrator.
