I. Textbook Assignment Options:

A. *World History, Patterns of Interaction*, Part I (5.0 credits)

- Read chapters 1-11.
- Complete “Section Assessment” exercises; **omit** “Connect to Today”.
- Complete: all “Chapter Assessments – Terms & Names, Main Ideas, Critical Thinking (choose 3 out of 5) and Standards-Based Assessment”.
- Complete two of the Extension Activities listed below.

B. *World History Connections to Today, The Modern Era*, Part I (5.0 credits)

- Read Review Units I-IV. Complete all review questions.
- Read Chapters 1-10.
- Complete “Section Review” exercises (**omit**: “Activity” exercises)
- Complete Chapter Review exercises: “Analyzing Primary Sources” and “Analyzing Map, Graph, or Table” activities.
- Complete two of the Extension Activities listed below.

C. *World History, The Human Experience*, Part I (5.0 credits)

- Read Chapters 4-6, 16-24.
- Complete “Section Review” questions 1-3 only.
- Complete two of the Extension Activities listed below.

D. *World History, The Human Experience: The Modern Era*, Part I (5.0 credits)

- Read Chapters 2, 5, 6, 8-14, 16.
- Complete all “Section Review” questions 1-3 only.
- Complete: all “Reviewing Facts” and “Skill Practice” activities in the “Chapter Assessments”.
- Complete two of the Extension Activities listed below.

II. Extension Activity Options:

1. Research a major religion of your choice. Write a 2-page essay, or complete a 15-slide PowerPoint presentation that includes the following information:
 - The founding of the religion
 - Basic beliefs and practices
 - The religion’s founder(s)
 - What, if any, persecution for the believers
 - Any special observances and/or holidaysIf the essay is selected, use Writing Rubric Exp. CP.
2. Choose and research 10 inventions from the Industrial Revolution. Write a 2-page essay in which you describe each invention and explain how it has helped American society. In addition, keep a log of your activities for one week. Explain how your week would have been different if you had been living in the pre-industrial world. Use Writing Rubric Exp. CP.

3. Create a map of Europe between 1914 and 1918, indicating the countries and major cities. Site the location of 10 major WWI battles on the map. On a separate sheet of paper, write a 2-page essay explaining how these battles had an affect on WWI. Use Writing Rubric Exp. CP.
4. Using the Internet or library, research WWI propaganda from 8 different countries. Write a 2-page essay comparing and contrasting the forms and functions of the various propaganda items. Use Writing Rubric Exp. CP.
5. Teacher generated activity, approved by the site administrator.
