  - a. U.S. President
  - b. California's two U.S. Senators
  - c. California's Governor
  - d. California's Representative for the 21<sup>st</sup> District
  - e. State Assembly Representative for the 32<sup>nd</sup> District
  - f. State Senator for the 17<sup>th</sup> District
2. Use the Internet to research the life of John F. Kennedy, Martin Luther King, Jr., or Cesar Chavez. Write a 1-paragraph summary based upon your research. Use Writing Rubric S I.
3. Use the following Internet address to review the United States Holocaust Memorial exhibit: [www.ushmm.org](http://www.ushmm.org). At the main web page, click on the icon "personal histories." Find and read about one of the holocaust survivors. Write a 1-paragraph summary of the life of one survivor.
