They will learn the basic operation and maintenance of the fundamental equipment and technology required to produce a video. Students will also learn about the creative process related to multimedia, how to manage a project’s timeline, and legal issues. Students will demonstrate an understanding of the creative process and evaluation of that process. 4. Students will be able to create still graphics. 5. Students will demonstrate an understanding of the career search process and tools in the field of video production. 6. Students will be able to demonstrate basic troubleshooting techniques as well as the procedures for the care and maintenance of the broadcast equipment. Students will learn basics of non-linear editing.
